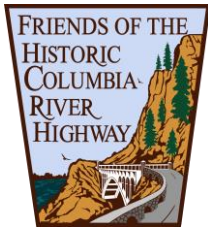

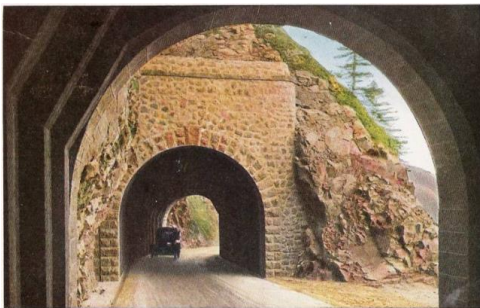

Fifth Annual Friends of the Historic Columbia River Highway

Antique Car Tour through the Mosier Twin Tunnels

Friends of the Historic Columbia River Highway announce the fifth annual Antique Auto Tour, to be held July 12, 2014. The 34 mile tour begins and ends at the Western Antique Aeroplane and Automobile Museum (WAAAM), 1600 Air Museum Road, Hood River, OR 97031 (phone 541-308-1600). It will proceed to the Senator Mark O. Hatfield West Trailhead, then along the Historic Columbia River Highway State Trail, through the Mosier Twin Tunnels, through the city of Mosier to Rowena Crest and return to WAAAM, visiting incredible scenery along the way.

Planes Fly, Cars Drive, Engines Roar

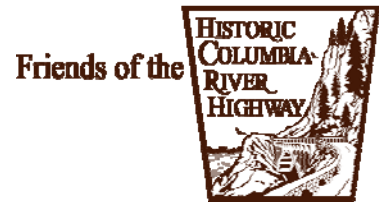
